- 4) Reports
 - a. Pastor's Report: There were 2 October funerals. Pastor Dana gave us general plans for the next few months.
 - b. President's Report: Sandy mentioned the ALICE training that was held on Sunday October 13th.

- c. Secretary's Report: Chuck made a motion to approve the September 17, 2024, council meeting minutes. Brad seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- d. Financial Administrator's Report: Patrick reported that giving is down, but also expenses are down. The church needs a blower. Winona Controls' bid is \$999. Jess made a motion to accept Winona Controls' bid. Lynn seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.
- 5) Cabinet Reports
 - a. Education: Sunday School is going well. The Christmas program is up and planned. There are usually 12 to 15 children. It's Denise's rotation.
 - b. Evangelism: Brad and Mike will be going to the Hunger Task Force on October 22 to help the Houston Food Pantry. In September they were able to pick up 245 lbs. of food. Ellen Hongerholt continues to meet for bible study. Mike sends thanks to those who volunteered to help with roadside cleanup on October 6.
 - c. Finance: September was a breakeven month. Giving came in slightly better than budget, and expenses were lower than budget. Repairs expense was above budget; the new boiler and cross staining were part of this. For the year, we are running about \$10K behind budget. Giving is \$19K below budget for the year through September, but this is offset by lower Education, Personnel, Utilities and Stewardship/Mission expenses. The finance committee will speak to the congregation on October 27th. It was suggested to put the gift of grain letter in the parish visitor.
 - d. Personnel: The Personnel Cabinet will oversee custodian's duties going forward to give Pastor one less thing to deal with at this time. The Personnel Cabinet met with the bishop to discuss Pastor's sick days.
 - e. C of C Ground: We had contracted mowing for 25 times per year. We have 2 weeks in the bank. B & D from Caledonia gave a bid of \$1,100 for parking lines in front of the church. After a discussion, it was decided to wait until spring and get a crew of volunteers to complete this job.
 - f. C of C Building: Tim Buckland stained the outdoor wooden cross on the north side of the church. There were reports that the kitchen stove burners weren't working properly. Keith will get Hobart in to check over them.
 - g. Stone Church/Cemetery: High school students will be cleaning up at the cemetery on Friday.
 - h. Stewardship & Missions: We are looking for volunteers.
 - i. Workship & Music: Bluetooth was used during the Edwards wedding.
 - j. Youth & Family: There was a good turnout at the Fall Fest. There were 3 full wagon rides.
 - k. WELCA: The circle meetings are in the afternoons. The quilts and kits that were created during Due Days were sent on Saturday. The fall supper was a success with 795 carry-out meals being sold.
